# Add some sparkle!

*Preserving a memory or trying to make sure your scrapbook page/craft project reflects the wonder of the moment as close to the true way it was, can be a challenge.*



**Of course the photo is the most important element** on all our scrapbook pages, but sometimes the photo represents a moment that was so special, that our add on elements need something extra special to preserve the moment in its true splendour. In the photo above, the golden rays of the sun inspired Cariena to use yellow/gold as a highlight colour. She added the teal and green as complimentary accent colours. Coral was picked up from the colours of the couple's complexions, adorned softly by the late afternoon sun.

The photo was matted onto a matching yellow cardstock after the edges were sanded to just make it "pop" a little more. She also rounded the corners to make it softer.

Little Birdie's Andrea Pastel flowers with some leftover Prima yellow flowers from her stash were added, as well as handmade Silkfoam flowers matching the colour scheme.


Her title was coloured using inks she had available and then a layer of Stickles, Little Birdie Sparkle Pastes, Nuvo Drops etc were added for sparkle



## FROM TOP TO BOTTOM:

1. You can see the simple handmade Silkfoam Flower in the top photo. Adding the green center, makes it stand out among the other flowers.
2. The photo in the center shows how Heat Embossing can alter any element. After colouring a piece of white cardstock, Cariena die cut the script and then added a layer of Tsukineko Bridal Embossing Powder. It softened the element and added some sparkle.
3. In the final photo you can see how subtle, yet effective, the Little Birdie Sparkle Paste looks on the background. It just adds that little bit of extra life to the dark background.

*In the next sample , very little sparkle was added - just a touch here and there to enhance the elements and because it was fun!*




Carlena wanted to create a layout with several photos, still using sparkle to enhance her elements.

She painted the chipboard frames and houses with Nuvo Mousse. She then applied a layer of dry glitter mixed with some Glossy Accents/Gloss Gel Medium over the yellow house. She coloured the circle die cut using a variety of paints and inks (Rust Paste, Nuvo, All Purpose Inks and more) She used the same technique to add some glitter to the circles.
