In Your Kit:

4 x Patterned Papers
2 x White Cardstock
1 x Brown Cardstock
Sticker Sheet
Embellishment Pack
2 x Technique Pieces
Title

Photo Requirements:

2 x 9.5cm x 9.5cm
1 x 10cm x 15cm
Portrait
1 x 15cm x 10cm
Landscape

Tools and Product Required:

Basic Tools, Brown ink for chalking, Red/Green/Yellow/Blue Liquid Pearls
Stencil with small design
Stickles. Scattered Straw Distress Ink and Blending Tool w/Clean Foam.
Word Stamps
Mister Bottle w/water
Thin Paint Brush, Glossy Accents (Optional)

Creating your Technique Pieces:

1. We are first going to prepare our background and technique pieces.
2. On your craft sheet, squeeze a blob of each colour of Liquid Pearls about 5cm apart.
3. Mist with water and use your paint brush to mix each colour separately. Pick up some of each colour with the paint brush and flick it onto your white background Cardstock. Use the layout as a guide for where the splats will be visible. Leave this to dry.
4. Take the white piece with "The Good Stuff" stamped onto it and lightly place it into each colour of the mixed Liquid pearls separately. Give it a little twist when you place it. Do not overdo it – you will make mud! Leave this to dry.
5. Place your stencil over the strip of technique paper and add some Liquid Pearls directly from the bottle to the stencil. Rub it into the design with your finger. You can use two or three colours or just one. Remove the stencil and leave to dry completely. Once dry, use Scattered Straw Distress Ink and Blend over the dry Liquid Pearls. It will resist the ink. We will now assemble the layout.



Love the way the Liquid Pearls resist the Distress Ink!!

Step by Step Instructions: (all edges were inked with brown ink):

1. From the green Paper, cut one piece of 5cm x 18cm (2" x 7") and one piece of 2.5cm x 30.5cm (1" x 12")
2. From the Red Dot Paper, cut one piece of 4cm x 30.5cm (1.75" x 12") and a piece of 5cm x 15cm (2" x 6")
3. From the Blue Stripe Paper, cut a piece of 12.5cm x 12.5cm (5" x 5") 17.5cm x 12.5cm (7" x 5")
4. From the Yellow Dot Paper cut a piece of 7.5cm x 15cm (3" x 6") and 7.5cm x 12.5cm (3" x 5")
5. From the Brown Script Paper, cut a piece of 7.5cm x 10cm (3" x 4") and 7.5cm x 15cm (3" x 6")
6. Sand and Matt your photos. All my photos were raised using Fun Foam.
7. Assemble the papers onto your background using the layout as a placement guide.
8. Create the heart accents by using the die cuts from your pack and the sticker sheet. Add Stickles to the hearts and leave to dry.
9. Add the flower clusters, die cut leaves and bling to your page.
10. From your resist and blended yellow technique piece, cut a banner to the same width as your large paper clip in your pack. Fold it over and add to your main flower cluster. Raise "The Good Stuff" technique piece with fun foam and mount it onto brown cardstock. Add to your cluster.
11. Glue your title to the layout and cover with a layer of Glossy Accents. This will darken the title.
12. Make bows with your twine and add them to the heart clusters. All done!
