- 1 x 12 x 12 Sticker Sheet
- 1 x 4x6 Journaling Card Elements #2510
- 1 x 2 x12 Border & Title Elements #2514
- 1 x Quote & Mat Photo Elements #2513
- 1 x 6 x 12 Page Elements #2515
- 1 x Orange Stripe/Ledger #2517
- 3 x Navy/Icons #2520
- 2 x Punched Border Strips
- Jute Cord

Photos Required:

- 5 x 8.5cm x 9cm portrait Photos

Tools Required:

- Basic Tools
- Foam Tape/Small Strips or small dots
- Brown ink
- Sharp Scissors
- Tombow Green Glue

Cutting List: (all the pieces throughout the kit were inked with brown ink)

1. From #2517 cut a piece of 30cm x 19cm
2. From #2513 cut the piece with the Plaid and the piece with the dots and brown bracket shape. Also cut the 4 icons from the one square and fussy cut the trees from the other square
3. From #2510 fussy cut the "wilderness certified" piece
4. From #2515 cut out the small piece with the words "outdoor adventure"
5. From #2514 choose a title – I chose ADVENTURE and also kept the stripes
6. Also from #2514 cut the strip with the words NATURE, DISCOVER, ADVENTURE, EXPLORE
7. From one of your #2520 pieces, cut a strip measuring 2cm x 30cm. Also cut 5 pieces measuring 11.5cm x 9.5cm and 5 pieces of 11cm x 9cm. These will become your polaroid frames.

Assembling the page:

1. Place your remaining two sheets of #2520 with the light side facing up, next to each other and lightly stick them together.
2. Take the piece of #2517 (Orange Stripe) and adhere it in the middle of the two pages, about 2cm from the top
3. Adhere the piece of Plaid paper cut from #2513 to the left of the orange piece, letting it slant a bit as shown in the picture.
4. Take the piece with the dots and repeat it on the right side.
5. Glue the title piece down at the bottom of the Orange piece, about 2cm from the bottom.
6. Take your photos and glue them onto the 5 pieces of #2520 measuring 11.5cm x 9.5cm, with the light side up. Using your craft knife, cut a block of 7.5cm x 8cm starting (.5cm from the top) from the remaining 5 pieces of paper cut from #2520. Blue side up. Add foam strips to the inside of the polaroid frame and adhere over photo. Voilà! A polaroid frame!
7. Arrange the photos as shown onto the page.
8. Take one of the strips of punched borders and ruffle it a bit. Trim down to matt it onto the piece of 2cm x 30cm #2520 that was cut. Take the other piece and glue some of it next to the plaid piece on the left.
9. Clue this piece over the orange piece, 3cm from the top.
10. Glue the strip with words about 2cm underneath that.
11. Finish the page off by adding the trees and other cut out elements as shown in the photo. Add stickers from the sticker sheet to the bottom of the polaroid frames
12. Jute cord – add a line of Tombow glue where you want the Jute, and leave to become tacky. Press the Jute into the glue!
