- 1 x Bo Bunny Paper (cut)
- 1 x DCWV Paper
- 1 x 3" x 12" Blue Paper
- 2 x Stamped Blue Paper Strips
- 2 x Scallop Punched Paper Strips
- 1 x Blue Bracket Punched Strip
- 1 x Small Piece of Cardstock
- 2 x Sets of Die Cut Cream Alphabets
- 30 x Gold Brads
- 3 x Black brads

Brown Dotted Ribbon

Measuring Tape Ribbon

Rope

- 3 x Adage Tickets
- 1 x Metal Frame
- 2 x Brown Cardstock Hinges

Various Stamped images

Piece of Chipboard

Photos Required:

1 x 6" x 5" (15cm x 13cm)

2 x 4" x 3.5" (10cm x 8cm)

2 x 3" x 2.75" (7.5cm x 7cm)

Glossy Accents

Black Journaling Pen

Adhesives

Paper Piercer

Scissors

Completing your layout Step by Step:

- 1. Lightly adhere your two brown Cardstocks to each other
- 2. Cut your Bo Bunny Striped paper in two pieces measuring 4" x 10" (10cm x 25.5cm) and 8" x 10" (20.5cm x 25.5cm)
- 3. Using your DCWV Paper, cut 2 pieces of 4" x 10" (10cm x 25.5cm)
- 4. Start from the left of your layout and adhere the Blue Stamped strip approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.5cm) from the left.
- 5. Now add the one DCWV 4" piece.
- 6. Adhere the 8" x 10" Bo Bunny piece.
- 7. Glue down the other DCWV 4" piece.
- 8. Add the final Bo Bunny Striped piece.
- 9. Finish off with another strip of the Blue Stamped paper.
- 10. Using the two pieces of Scalloped paper, add one to each side of the layout as shown in the photo
- 11. Glue your cardstock hinges to the layout as shown almost top left page and almost bottom right page.
- 12. Using your paper piercer, pierce holes in the middle of all the scallops and where the openings in the hinges.
- 13. Fasten your shiny gold brads to these holes.
- 14. Positions your photos as desired, after trimming, matting and sanding them.
- 15. Position a piece of measuring ribbon, brown ribbon and the blue punched bracket piece underneath the two photos on the left page.
- 16. Ink your Adage Word tickets and place them under the blue brackets.
- 17. Cut flags from your left over papers and place them as shown on the page. Add brads to the center of the flags.
- 18. Use your string in the kits to complete the banner
- 19. Place two small pieces of ribbon under a photo on the right page if desired.
- 20. Mount the filmstrip onto the piece of Chipboard in the kit.
- 21. Add the stamped quote and the clock as shown.
- 22. From your alphabet, choose a title and adhere to page.
- 23. Add the metal frame, if so desired.
- 24. Cover the quotes, clock, title and inside of the metal frame with Glossy Accents and leave to dry overnight.
