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Tools, Photos and Products Required

5 x ½ sheets of shades of cream/black patterned paper
2 x White Cardstock – background
1 x Chipboard title
2 x sheets glossy cardstock (4 x 6)
6 x tags – 2 of each size
1 x Brown Cardstock
1 x Colour Cardstock
1 x White Cardstock (extra)
3 x Buttons
Blings (colour scheme)
Wax Cord
7 x 2" x 3" **PORTRAIT** photos **OR** 7 x **PORTRAIT** postcard photos that can be trimmed
1 x 5" x 7" **PORTRAIT** photo
Photos must have one DOMINANT colour.
Close ups are very good for this layout
Paper trimmer
Craft Knife
Metal Ruler
Green Tombow Glue
Double Sided Tape
Foam Tape/Fun Foam
Vintage Photo Distress Ink/Chalk for edging
Black Journaling Pen
Sanding Tool
Glue Dots
Craft Sheet
Colour Distress Ink that goes with layout
Glossy Accents
Kitchen Towel
Mini Mister filled with Water
Glue Dots
Blending Tool/Cut and Dry Foam Square
Versamark Inkpad/Resist Inkpad
One colour Distress Ink – dark is better
Border Punches
Background Stamps for Resist Technique
Journaling Stamp

How to Complete your layout step by step

1. Using all your patterned papers in your kit, cut them into strips so that you can cover your white background, but leave a 5cm piece on each side uncovered
2. Chalk all pieces of paper
3. Using your blending tool, blend your Resist paper with your chosen colour of Distress Ink
4. Arrange the strips as desired and glue down onto your background cardstock
5. Cut two strips of brown CS to 2cm x 30c.
6. Use a border punch and punch a border from each strip
7. Glue down on the edges of your pages
8. Using your chosen colour of Distress ink, cover your tags completely
9. Mist with water and dry with Heat Gun
10. Cover your title with Distress Ink and mist with water.
11. Dry with Heat Gun and repeat until desired effect is reached
12. Cover title with Glossy Accents and set aside to dry
13. Using Glossy Cardstock, stamp back ground stamp inked with Versamark ink
14. Dry with Heat Gun and cover with Distress Ink
15. Using paper towel, wipe ink off, revealing stamped image
16. Cut rectangle from inked CS and glue onto journal stamped CS
17. Sand all photos
18. Raise one of the 2" x 3" photos with Fun Foam/Foam Squares
19. Mount 5" x 7" Photo as desired
20. Glue photos down as per picture, arranging elements as shown
21. Add buttons and Diamanté strategically
22. Glue title down

NOTES: This layout is designed to show how effective it can be to use various patterned papers together and add one focal colour.
